Primary Function:

Sprays surfaces of machines, manufactured products, or working area with protective or decorative material such as paint, enamel, glaze, gel-coat, or lacquer by performing the following duties.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Interpret and select the correct application procedure to mix and apply coating material in accordance with specifications and product data sheets to achieve the correct wet and dry film thickness using conventional and airless spray equipment, brush or roller.
- Compute paint mixture formulas in accordance with specifications and product data sheets.
- Apply Urethanes, Epoxies, Tank Linings, Acrylics, Alkyds, Zinc Coatings, Enamels, and Lacquers.
- Verifies that parts or assemblies are properly prepared prior to receiving material application
- Verifies parts or assemblies are completely coated and the correct dry film thickness is achieved.
- Operate, clean, troubleshoot, and perform maintenance on conventional and airless spray painting equipment.
- Operates overhead cranes and forklifts.
- Operate sandblasting equipment to achieve the correct blast profile.
- Direct and train others as required.
- Cleans grease and dirt from product.
- Applies masking tape over parts and areas that are not to be coated.
- Fills cavities and dents with putty to attain smooth surface.
- Removes rust from metal with acid, wire brush, or steel wool.
- Perform other duties as required.

Promote and actively embrace the concept of professionalism, with an emphasis on quality, commitment, integrity, ingenuity, teamwork, the community and the environment. Safety is a deeply rooted cultural value and it must be promoted and enforced at all times.

Minimum Qualifications/Experience:

High school diploma or general education degree (GED); or three to five years related experience related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.

Must be able to pass respirator testing and fit test.

Additional skills

Strong interpersonal skills and ability to work in a very dynamic environment – must have flexibility with an ability to focus.

Other Qualifications

The physical demands and work environment described here are representative of the conditions that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Physical Demands

While performing the duties of this Job, the employee is regularly required to stand. The employee is frequently required to walk; use hands to finger, handle, or feel; reach with hands and arms; climb or balance; stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl and talk or hear. The employee is occasionally required to sit and taste or smell. The employee must regularly lift and /or move up to 10 pounds, frequently lift and/or move up to 25 pounds and occasionally lift and/or move up to 50 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, color vision and ability to adjust focus

Work Environment

While performing the duties of this Job, the employee is regularly exposed to moving mechanical parts and fumes or airborne particles. The employee is frequently exposed to high, precarious places and vibration. The employee is occasionally exposed to wet and/or humid conditions; toxic or caustic chemicals; outside weather conditions and risk of electrical shock. The noise level in the work environment is usually loud.
