Primary Function:

Tends fabricating machines such as cutoff saws, shears, rolls, brakes, presses, forming machines, and punch, that cut, shape, and bend metal plates, sheets, tubes, and structures.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assist or operate various CNC machines in the Material Prep Department, such as, Band Saws, Press Brake, Plate Rolls, Water Jet, Plasma Table and Laser. Also, operates assorted hand tools, including grinders, bevellers and precision measuring tools.
- Has a working knowledge of drawings, sketches, specifications and other means to produce quality parts.
- Needs to work with a high degree of safety in a team player atmosphere with little supervision.
- Must also operate forklifts, be able to lift up to 50 pounds using correct lifting techniques, have good manual dexterity, vision and hearing.

Promote and actively embrace the concept of professionalism, with an emphasis on quality, commitment, integrity, ingenuity, teamwork, the community and the environment. Safety is a deeply rooted cultural value and it must be promoted and enforced at all times.

Minimum Qualifications/Experience:

High school diploma or general education degree (GED); or three to five years related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.

Physical Demands

While performing the duties of this Job, the employee is regularly required to stand. The employee is frequently required to walk; use hands to finger, handle, or feel; reach with hands and arms; stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl and talk or hear. The employee is occasionally required to sit; climb or balance and taste or smell. The employee must regularly lift and /or move up to 10 pounds, frequently lift and/or move up to 25 pounds and occasionally lift and/or move up to 50 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, color vision and ability to adjust focus.

Work Environment

While performing the duties of this Job, the employee is regularly exposed to moving mechanical parts. The employee is frequently exposed to vibration. The employee is occasionally exposed to high, precarious places and fumes or airborne particles. The noise level in the work environment is usually loud.
