Primary Function:

Tend to fabricating machines such as cutoff saws, shears, rolls, brakes, presses, forming machines, and punch, that cut, shape, and bend metal plates, sheets, tubes, and structures.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assist or operate various manual and CNC machines in the Material Prep Department, such as: Band Saws, Press Brake, Plate Rolls, Water Jet, Plasma Table and Laser.
- Operate assorted hand tools, including grinders, bevellers and precision measuring tools.
- Have a working knowledge of drawings, sketches, specifications and be able to produce work that meet those specifications.
- Must be forklift certified, able to understand and use appropriate rigging techniques and trained in bridge crane operation.
- Be able to lift up to 50 pounds using correct lifting techniques, have good manual dexterity, vision and hearing.

Promote and actively embrace the concept of professionalism, with an emphasis on quality, commitment, integrity, ingenuity, teamwork, the community and the environment. Safety is a deeply rooted cultural value and it must be promoted and enforced at all times.

Minimum Qualifications/Experience:

High school diploma or general education degree (GED); or five years related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.

Other Qualifications

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

Physical Demands

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is frequently required to walk; use hands to finger, handle, or feel; reach with hands and arms and climb or balance. The employee will often move/position heavy pieces of metal, torso twist, stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl and talk and hear. The employee is frequently required to stand, often for extended periods; the employee must frequently lift and /or move up to 25 pounds, occasionally lift and/or move up to 50 pounds and rarely lift and/or move weight above 50 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include strong visual acuity (with or without correction), color vision, peripheral vision and depth perception.

Work Environment

While performing the duties of this Job, the employee is regularly exposed to moving mechanical parts. The employee is frequently exposed to vibration. The employee is occasionally exposed to high, precarious places and fumes or airborne particles. The noise level in the work environment is usually loud.
